The people of Maryland have a deep-rooted understanding of and appreciation for the significance of their historical and cultural WHEREAS. legacy and the important place in the sweeping expanse of our nation's history these important resources occupy; and

Historic preservation is recognized for the key role it has played in numerous successful community and economic development projects WHEREAS, around the State and as an essential component of economic and community development strategies in urban, suburban, and rural communities across Maryland, which have made historic preservation work to stimulate the State and local economies, revitalize neighborhoods, inspire local pride and maintain community character while improving our understanding of place; and

This year is the fiftieth anniversary of the National Historic Preservation Act, which established the nation's legal framework for the WHEREAS, protection and preservation of historic buildings, landscapes, and archaeological discoveries upon being signed into law on October 15, 1966; and

The State of Maryland and its many local partners work closely to develop preservation programs that meet the highest standards and WHEREAS, which strive to preserve historic resources for the economic benefit and cultural enlightenment of all Marylanders; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LAWRENCE J. HOGAN, JR., GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim MAY 2016, as MARYLAND PRESERVATION MONTH in Maryland and do commend this observance to all of our citizens.
