This a brand new grant program administered by Preservation Maryland in partnership with the Maryland Historical Trust, Baltimore Heritage, Inc and the Baltimore City Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation. The goal of the Fund, supported by the Baltimore Community Foundation, is to provide direct assistance for activities that preserve neighborhood identity and contribute to revitalization. In this first round. nine projects totaling \$70,000 in awards were selected from a highly competitive field of nearly forty applicants. The Committee will recommend a course of action for protecting and preserving Brunswick's rich historic and cultural resources.




