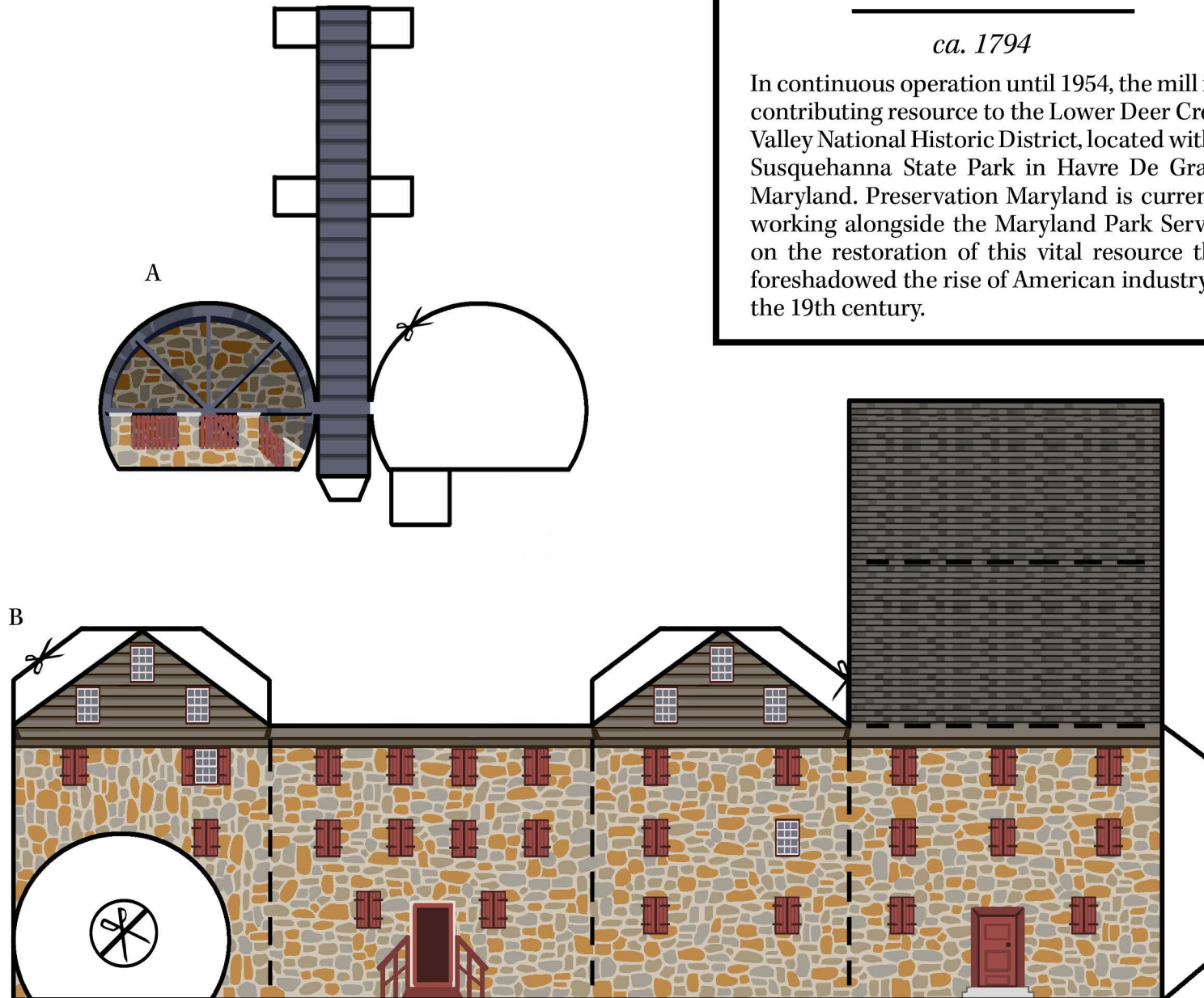


## Rock Run Mill

*ca. 1794*

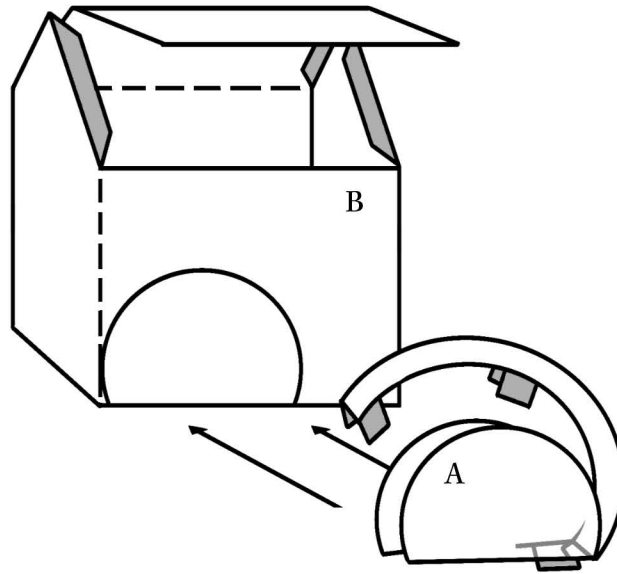
In continuous operation until 1954, the mill is a contributing resource to the Lower Deer Creek Valley National Historic District, located within Susquehanna State Park in Havre De Grace, Maryland. Preservation Maryland is currently working alongside the Maryland Park Service on the restoration of this vital resource that foreshadowed the rise of American industry in the 19th century.
